

# Featured sessions from the agenda

## To what extent should the Asian sustainability agenda be different to Western priorities?

- » EU is often regarded as the leader when it comes to sustainable finance regulatory frameworks, how far is Asia as compared to the EU?
- » Is regulatory convergence a good thing?
