

Did you know you can earn CPE credits at CFO Data & Technology 2024? Here's what to know:

How can receive credits at the event?

Credits are earned by attending complete sessions and by ensuring that your badge is scanned on **entry and exit.**

You will find a member of our team wearing a pink shirt at the doors of each qualifying session. They will scan your badge and your participation will be recorded. **Please note you will not receive any credits if you do not locate our team member and have your badge scanned.**

How are credits calculated?

Credits are calculated solely based on time spent in a CPE eligible session.

What are the total number of credits available?

The total number of credits varies based on the event and is determined by Event Operations staff. Please note, not all sessions offer credits.

Which sessions are ineligible for credit?

Non educational sessions i.e. welcome, housekeeping instructions and breaks. Please find eligible sessions below.

Are speakers eligible for credits?

Yes, speakers are eligible to receive two times the number of credits offered for their session.

How are credits calculated? Why am I missing credits?

Credits are calculated solely based on the time spent in a CPE eligible session. If you do not have your badge scanned on entry **and** exit, your attendance cannot be verified.

When can I expect to receive my certificate?

Certificates are typically available within 3 business days following the event. You will receive a link to our CPE portal where you can download your certificate.



• Do I need a password to print my certificate?

No, please enter the email you registered for the event along with your first and last name to download a PDF of your certificate.

How long will my certificate be available?

Certificates are available for one calendar year following the event.
