## Key takeaways from the Forum




- 1. Many Korean institutional investors have raised their concerns over the increasing hedging cost when investing with overseas real estate funds. In particular, when investors make an investment with any US dollar currency funds, the hedging cost over US dollar are relatively higher than other currency funds which encouraged them to look into Europe, Asia and Australia markets.
- Korean investors continue displaying high appetite for oversea real estate debt funds and are actively looking to allocate more capital in 2019 and beyond. For Korean LPs, real estate debt funds are still their safe-bet, for a decent return with relatively low risk.
- 3. Europe and the US are still amongst the key core areas of interest for Korean investors. However, most active investors including KTCU, Korea Post, GEPS and Korean insurers have indicated their preference to invest in first-tier cities in Europe, Asia and Australia.
- 4. Korean insurers have expressed their strong investment focus in real asset debt investment with a decline of interest in investing in equity funds. Some larger Korean insurers have also announced their goals in increasing their debt allocations in 2019 during the panel discussion.


